Early start and drive south-east 240km to Amboseli National Park. This park is situated in Kenya right on the border to Tanzania and in the shadow of Africa's highest mountain Mt Kilimanjaro. Our Serena Lodge is built to resemble "manyattas" which are typical Masai villages. Afternoon game drive. (B, L, D)

typically be breakfast around 8.30am after morning game drive then free time and lunch until 4pm. This park contains many common species of East African wildlife: lions, giraffes, wildebeests, wart hogs, zebra, hyenas and hippos. The elephants play the leading role against the backdrop of Mt Kilimanjaro. At Amboseli you are also invited to participate in an Acacia Tree Planning program to assist in preserving the local environment. Here you will experience



the most accessible viewing of elephants anywhere in the world. (B, L, D)

Wed 30th June – LAKE MANYARA
After an early game drive we check out and drive to the border town of Namanga. After clearing immigration we drive to the Great Rift Valley and to Lake Manyara National Park. (B, L, D)

Thur 1st July - NGORONGORO
Morning game drive Lake Manyara then drive to Ngorongora Crater. After lunch and check in, we have an extended afternoon game drive. (B,L,D)

Fri 2nd July - SERENGETI
After check out we drive west to Olduvai Gorge for a museum visit. We continue our game drive today to the vast National Park of Serengeti. (B,L,D)



Sat 3rd July – SERENGETI
Two game drives today and a real chance to see cats, Wildebeest and Zebra. (B,L,D)

Sun 4th July – SERENGETI
Game drive enroute to Masai Mara National Reserve, Kenya. We follow the Wildebeest migration path. (B,L,D)



Mon 5th July – MASAI MARA
Two game drives today. Special Bush Breakfast today after our first game drive. (B,L,D)

Tue 6th July – MASAI MARA
Today you may take the opportunity to have a balloon ride over the vast Mara plains (optional extra). Tonight we have a special Bush Dinner. (B,L,D)

Wed 7th July – LAKE NAKURU
Transfer to local Mara Serena Airport and fly to Nairobi. After lunch we proceed 140km north west to Lake Nakuru National Park. Game drive on the way. (B,L,D)

Thu 8th July – LAKE NAKURU
This park is 188 sq. km., and mainly features the alkaline lake covering 62 sq. km. We will see Flamingoes and this is the best opportunity to see Rothchild's Giraffe and Rhino. (B,L,D)

Fri 9th July – TO NAIROBI
Check out from the hotel after morning game drive and drive back to Nairobi. We have day-use rooms today for our comfort. Free time before meeting at hotel by 8pm for transfer to airport. (B)

Sat 10th July – IN TRANSIT
In transit Nairobi – Hong Kong – Brisbane

Sun 11th July – ARRIVE BRISBANE
