Denmark, Norway, Sweden, Finland and Russia



Tue 10th Jul 2012

DEPART AUSTRALIA

Depart Brisbane (or other capital cities) for Copenhagen via Dubai.

Wed 11th Jul – COPENHAGEN, DENMARK

Arrive in Copenhagen and transfer to hotel. Afternoon free to explore Denmark's Capital.

Thu 12th Jul – COPENHAGEN

After breakfast, explore the city on a guided sightseeing tour which will finish at the famous Little Mermaid Statue. Afternoon at leisure. (B)

Fri 13th Jul – OSLO, NORWAY

After breakfast and a leisurely morning we meet our tour manager before transferring to the pier for our overnight ferry to Oslo. (B)

Sat 14th Jul – OSLO

Breakfast on board. Disembark and

enjoy a 3 hour city sightseeing tour of the Norwegian capital including the view over Oslofjord from the Opera house and a visit to Bygdoy Island and Vigeland Sculpture Park. Afternoon at leisure. (B)

Sun 15th Jul – OSLO

Breakfast at hotel and a morning tour to the Viking Museum, Kon-tiki Museum and Fram Museum. (B)

Mon 16th Jul – GEILO

After breakfast depart Oslo and drive through a landscape of pine forests and lakes to Geilo, a small town surrounded by mountains. (B,D)

Tue 17th Jul – BERGEN

Today we head towards the Hardanger Fjord, stopping at the thundering



Voringfoss waterfall. Enjoy an afternoon tour of Norway's 2nd largest city including St Marys Church, Haakon's Hall, the colourful fish markets and the old Bryggen area. (B)

Wed 18th Jul – BERGEN

Today is a rest day to relax or explore. (B)

Thu 19th Jul – STALHEIM/FLAM

Today we travel via the mountain village of Voss to Stalheim to enjoy breathtaking view of the Stalheim Gorge. Continue to Naeroy Valley for a ferry trip along the stunning Naeroyfjord. We also enjoy a trip on the Flam Railway one of the world's most spectacular train journeys. (B,D)

Fri 20th Jul – LILLEHAMMER

Travel from Flam via the Lærdal Tunnel to Lærdal and onto Fagernes stopping at the famous Borgund Stave Church (entrance optional). Continue to Lillehammer and the Olympic Park before checking into our hotel. (B,D)

Sat 21st Jul – STOCKHOLM, SWEDEN

A visit today to the open-air museum of Maihaugen with its 200 old and new buildings, exhibitions, cafes and lots of activities. From here a drive through



beautiful forest landscapes to the capital of Sweden. (B)

Sun 22nd Jul – STOCKHOLM

Discover Stockholm on a city sightseeing tour which includes a walk along the narrow streets of the 750 year old Gamla Stan district. Afternoon free. (B)

Mon 23rd Jul – HELSINKI, FINLAND

Morning at leisure before transferring to the pier for the overnight ferry to Helsinki. Dinner on board. Standard outside cabin. (B,D)

Tue 24th Jul – HELSINKI

Morning arrival in Helsinki and enjoy a sightseeing tour of Finland's capital visiting Senate Square, the seaside Market Square, the Parliament Building and more. Afternoon at leisure. (B)

Wed 25th Jul – ST. PETERSBURG, RUSSIA

Transfer to Helsinki railway station for our journey by high speed train to St. Petersburg. Evening at leisure. (B)

Thu 26th Jul – ST. PETERSBURG

Morning city tour including the Peter and Paul Fortress, the Winter Palace, St Isaac's Cathedral and more. This afternoon a visit to the world-famous Hermitage Museum. (B)

Fri 27th Jul – ST. PETERSBURG

Spend the day exploring Peterhof and impressive 18th century palace surrounded by magnificent gardens and fountains. Afternoon visit to Zsarskoye Selo the home of the incredible Catherine's Palace. (B)

Sat 28th Jul – MOSCOW

Morning at leisure before afternoon transfer to railway station to board the high-speed train for Moscow. (B)

Sun 29th Jul – MOSCOW

Morning sightseeing tour of Moscow's highlights including Red Square and Kremlin, the Bolshoi Theatre and Moscow University. This afternoon enjoy an excursion to the Kremlin grounds and cathedrals. (B)

Mon 30th Jul – DEPART MOSCOW

Afternoon departure for Australia. Transit via Dubai. Arrive Aust Wed 1st August.
