Tuesday 21 April, 2020 DEPART AUSTRALIA FOR NEW YORK CITY!! 2 nights

Depart Australia for 'The Big Apple', New York City. On arrival transfer to our centrally located hotel and settle in for 2 nights. A welcome dinner tonight in the city that never sleeps. (D)

Wed 22 Apr - NEW YORK

An introduction to this exciting city today with a visit to the elegant Empire State Building and its open air 86th Floor Observation Deck. Wall Street, The NY Stock Exchange and the bustling icon Times Square are all on our list of sightseeing today. (B)

Thu 23 Apr - BOSTON 2 nights

We leave New York for now and drive towards Boston via Newport, Rhode Island. The mansions of Newport are a sight to see and afterwards we will continue on to the Cradle of Liberty, Boston. (B)

Fri 24 Apr - BOSTON

A combination of sightseeing and free time today to explore the history of Boston and tour the city's redbrick Freedom Trail including the Old North Church and Boston Harbor of "Boston Tea Party" fame. (B)

Sat 25 Apr - MONTREAL 2 nights

Leaving Boston we'll travel through

Sun 26 Apr - MONTREAL

An interesting sightseeing journey today including historic sites in the colourful Old Port area, Downtown Montreal & Notre Dame Basilica. (B)

Mon 27 Apr - QUEBEC CITY 3 nights

Leaving Montreal we travel to Quebec City stopping to sample the flavours of the region at an included lunch. This evening is at our leisure. (B, L)

Tue 28 Apr - QUEBEC CITY

An in-depth city tour today of this charming city including the winding streets, historic sights and military past both French and English and learn more about the colonial battle on the Plains of Abraham. Tonight immerse yourself in authentic Quebec during a cooking workshop. (B,D)

Wed 29 Apr - QUEBEC CITY

Today is yours to explore as you like. As you make your way through 'La Vieille Capitale' (The Old Capital) you will be enchanted by its beauty and charm. Wander through the 400 year old fortified heritage district walking along cobble-stone lanes, exploring galleries, restaurants and museums and taking in the ambience of this French speaking city. Thu 30 Apr - OTTAWA 2 nights

A new city today as we farewell Quebec City and travel to Ottawa where an introductory tour will provide views of the elegant Gothic buildings of Parliament Hill and Rideau Hall, the residence of the Governor General of Canada. (B)

Fri 1 May - OTTAWA

A full free day today for you to explore Ottawa at your own pace. You might like to take a ride down the Rideau Canal, visit the ByWard Market, an historic farmers market



and shopping district or visit The National Gallery. (B)

Sat 2 May - TORONTO 2 nights

Sun 3 May - TORONTO

Tue 5 May - LANCASTER COUNTY 2 nights

Today we explore rural Pennsylvania and get an insight into the culture and lifestyle of the oldest Amish order in America. The Amish and the Mennonites live much the same now as they did when they first settled here over 200 years ago. (B,D)

Thu 7 May – WASHINGTON D.C. 2 nights

Our next stop is the Nation's Capital, Washington D.C. There is so much to see and do in this city and your tour escort and tour manager will be on hand to provide suggestions for this free afternoon on our arriving in the city. You may choose to visit one of the many Smithsonian Museums along The

National Mall which are open until 5.30pm daily. (B)

Today we leave Philadelphia and return to our final destination, The Big Apple, New York City. On arrival the rest of the afternoon is yours to settle in and get ready to explore the city that never sleeps. (B)

Mon 11 May – NEW YORK CITY

A leisurely start to the morning before taking a scenic cruise on The Hudson River to the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island. You will have access to the grounds of Ellis Island and Liberty Island including The Pedestal and the recently



opened Statue of Liberty Museum. (B)

Tue 12 and Wed 13 May – NEW YORK CITY

The next 2 days are your days. Do whatever you want in one of the most exciting cities in the world!!
